Microteaching Audio-Visual Instructions

Set Up - when you arrive

- Turn on the power-bar on the cart with the DVD recorder
- o Turn on the speakers
- o Turn on the DVD
- o Turn on the room projector
- Hit the REC SPEED button on the DVD remote to make sure it is on "XP" speed, which is the best.
 - Turn on the camera (slide switch on top to the left)
- o Start the camera recording onto its VHS we don't actually use the VHS but you have to do this or else the camera will automatically turn off due to lack of use after about 5 minutes.

At the start of each of the 4 talks

- o Insert a new disk (it takes about 30 seconds to load)
- Attach the wireless mic to the speaker, turn it on, make sure you can hear throught the speakers
 - o Point the DVD remote control at the DVD, and press "Record"
- o Point the room projector remote control at the room projector, and press "RGB" to switch to the speaker's powerpoint (if needed) or you can just mute the video

After each talk

- o Point the DVD remote control at the DVD, and press "Stop" (it takes about 30 seconds to write to disc)
- Point the room projector remote control at the room projector, and press "Video"
 - o Point the DVD remote control at the DVD, and press "Play" watch the talk.
- o After watching, use the DVD remote control: press Setup, and use the arrows to select: → Disc → Finalize → Yes. It will take 5 or 6 minutes to finalize this is a good time for the group to discuss the talk and give feedback.
- You might want to rewind the VHS tape on the camera, and press record again (so the tape doesn't run out)
 - When you finally see "Title Menu", press eject, label DVD, give to speaker.

Before You Leave

- Turn off speakers
- Turn off camera
- Turn off room projector
- Turn off power bar on DVD cart
