# **Microteaching Audio-Visual Instructions**

## Set Up - when you arrive

- Set up and Turn on both laptops (one for presentations at the front, one for recording at the back)
- Use the remote control in the room to turn on the projector, select Computer1 input, lower the screen.
  - Use the remote to adjust Menu → Adjust, crank up Contrast and Brightness
- o Hook up speakers and video cable to the presentation laptop, so that it is projecting onto the front screen (you may have to push Function-F5 in order to toggle the display to the screen)
  - o On the recording laptop, start the Logitech Webcam software, aim the web-cam
  - o Click Quick Capture (it is a bit slow at first...)
- o Click Controls → Advanced Settings, unclick "RightLight", dial exposure to fairly low, dial gain to fairly high, click Save
  - o Unclick Autofocus, adjust to focus on the speaker (about 1/3 of the way)

### At the start of each of the 4 talks

 $\circ$  Click the Record button – you can watch the video and see how long the talk has been going on

### After each talk

- Stop recording (click the record button again)
- o Insert a USB drive, a Documents window should come up
- o Find the video in My Documents / My Videos / Logitech Webcam (there is a shortcut in the desktop)
  - Copy the most recent video file onto the USB drive (drag and drop)
  - Safely remove the USB drive
  - o Pull out the USB drive, and plug it into the presentation computer.
- o Go to My Computer, find the USB drive, copy the video onto the desktop (it plays faster that way)
  - o Safely remove the USB drive, eject it and give it to the presenter
  - o Double-click on the video (it looks like a pylon)

#### **Before You Leave**

- o Turn off speakers
- o Turn off both laptops
- o Turn off room projector
