This font is for creating timing diagrams in documents using a TrueType Symbol font. To meet these ends this is a monospaced font to allow for signal alignment in a timing diagram. Install the font onto your system as you would for any normal font, on most systems copying into the fonts folder is NOT guaranteed to work.

Anyone is allowed to use this font, however the only stipulation I make is that is not for resale as a font or part of a font taken from the original.

The font assumes English US mapping (as most fonts do by default), if other mappings are required use email address above and we can discuss alternative mappings. Suggestions of inclusions or removals will be considered, as this is the first draft and will be reviewed later. Check the website first for any updates.
